

4th of July FAQs

Q. What is Universal Studios Hollywood's 4th of July Fireworks Celebration?

A. Universal Studios Hollywood will feature an elaborate fireworks display for the full 4th of July weekend (July 2, 3 & 4) to celebrate Independence Day.

You can enjoy heart-pounding rides, shows and attractions, then keep the thrills going into the night and enjoy patriotic and Universal-themed music synchronized with fireworks as a memorable ending to your fun-filled day. You can also enjoy performances by The Fife and Drum throughout the day.

Q. Do you need to purchase a separate ticket to experience the fireworks?

A. No, this experience is included as part of your theme park admission.

Q. When and where can you see the fireworks?

A. The fireworks will begin at approximately 9:00 pm each evening on Saturday, July 2; Sunday, July 3; and Monday, July 4, 2022.

There will be two viewing locations: TRANSFORMERS[™]: The Ride-3D and at Universal Plaza.

Q. Will the rides and attractions continue to operate?

A. Yes, the Park and attractions will remain open for you to enjoy.

Q. Will you be able to view the fireworks from Universal CityWalk?

A. The fireworks will be visible from inside the Park. There is limited to no visibility on CityWalk.

Q. Will you be able to experience the Fireworks Celebration with an Annual or Season Pass?

A. Pass Members may attend depending on specific Pass type and calendar validity. Please refer to the back of your Pass for the link to your specific blackout calendar to see your valid dates.

If you're purchasing a new Pass, you may select any available date for your first visit at the time of purchase. Blackout dates may apply on return visits. Refer to the specific calendar for each Pass prior to your purchase.
